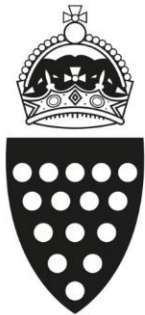
I have received contact from a resident looking to create a dog walking area behind the Meadlands. They have asked the Duchy to allow access from the recreation ground.

The Duchy are not willing to grant a right of access. If the Parish wanted to allow users of the dog walking field to access the field from the recreation ground, then the Duchy could grant a licence to allow you to do this but this would be for a set period of time and all liability would need to be accepted by the Parish. I would also request that the Duchy had copies of the relevant planning permission and insurances for the site.
